1 - STATE UPDATES FROM MAURICE

- THSBOA Eligibility status
 - Dues paid (local and state)
 - Pass background check
 - 4 badges on Arbiter that need to be completed
 - Dollar Sign Paid
 - Basketball Passed Rules Test with 70% or better
 - 100 Icon Passed Mechanics Test with 70% or better
 - Check Mark Background check is current
- Whistle covers are optional, not mandatory
- Masks
 - While officiating they are not mandatory
 - THSBOA has mandated that we wear masks while entering the facility, during pregame warmups and after the game
 - THSBOA has recommended that we wear masks between quarters and during timeouts.
 - ABC BOD agrees that crews will all wear the same style of mask and needs to be
 discussed in pregame. The default mask is a normal black mask that attaches at
 the ears. Other options include a mask with referee stripes and black neck gators.
 The crew must all wear the same style.
 - There's a possibility that THSBOA will make give out masks with logo on them.

- Team colors on masks are not going to matter
- Logos on player's masks are AGAINST the rules. NO LOGOS ON MASKS.
- Officials are not asked to police masks being worn on the bench by coaches or players. Schools will enforce these issues.
- If officials are uncomfortable with the fans not wearing masks they can finish the game and write a report to state after the game is over.
- Coaches Meeting instead of Captains Meeting
 - There will be no captains meeting with players this year. Instead there will be a
 coaches meeting at midcourt. It doesn't have to be the head coach. It can be any
 coach.
 - Officials will talk about the same stuff that they normally would in a captains meeting

Table

- There will be a maximum of 3 people at the scorer's table; clock operator, bookkeeper, and 1 other.
- Visiting bookkeeper will not be allowed at the scorer's table

Game Ball

Game ball isn't permitted to be used during warmups

Throw-in

- It's recommended that officials bounce the ball on baseline and endline in all scenarios this year.
- Copy of By-Laws and Constitution turned in to David Allen at THSBOA
- If the season gets to December 15th UIL will consider that a full season has been played
- During offseason leagues, THSBOA is asking that we wear shirts without the THSBOA logo on it.
 - Rick asked whether or not the insurance that THSBOA provides still covers summer league games. Maurice to confirm this
